




RESULTS IN DOLLARS



NUMBER OF BLOCAL BUILD **COLLEGE GRADUATES**




targeted positions filled by residents that live in focus area Baltimore City ZIP codes over four years. In FY23, 60% of targeted positions were filled by focus area residents.


